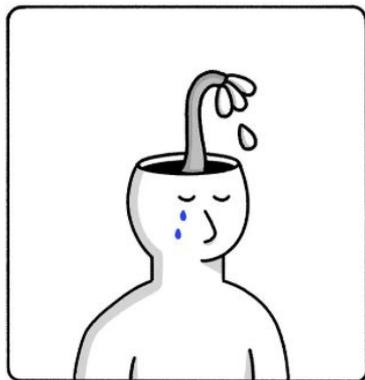

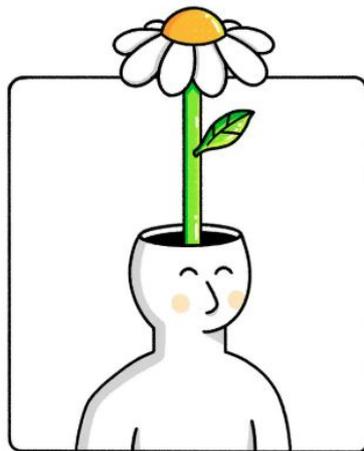

## What is AI?

AI - a broad umbrella term for many kinds of tools

LLM - large learning model

GPT - generative pre-trained transformer that uses LLM

Chat GPT - an app, a chat bot

Software that finds patterns from data and uses them to generate predictions.

## Safety and Privacy: Your Prepared Environment

Do NOT!

Temporary chat

Anonymize internal docs

Treat outputs as drafts

Real world risks



## Prompting Fundamentals

You are an expert fundraiser for a Montessori organization.

Goal: draft a warm donor email that invites a 20-minute call.

Context: Montessori program for orphaned children

Constraints: no pressure, no exclamation marks, 160–190 words.

Output: 2 subject lines + email + 1 short follow-up text.

Quality: list assumptions + 3 questions for me.



## One Habit That Makes Everything Better

Ask for a draft

Ask for critique and areas for improvement



## The First Step

Writing, analysis

Productivity tools

Creative tasks

Research



## Creative writing, emails - grammar check

I am a Montessori parent. I help my children develop their potential to the full. I prepare our environment at home so that it helps them in achieving this. I behave in such a way that they can learn from me. I know I am their most important teacher. I support them from the moment they are born to achieve independence and confidence. I include them in my every day life and the life of our family. I observe them and listen to them. I set up clear and fair boundaries. I respect their needs and developmental stages. I communicate kindly and in a positive way. I love them the way they are, without conditions and expectations.



## Prompt Patterns for Everyday Use

Ask me 5 clarifying questions first.

Give 3 versions: short / medium / punchy.

Rewrite for [audience] without Montessori jargon.

Make a checklist + timeline + owners.

List assumptions + what to verify.  
Find weak claims and improve them.  
Create a risk register with mitigations.  
Turn this into a table / template.



## Productivity Tools

- Translate Montessori into outcomes-based language
- Create agendas, meeting minutes, follow up tasks
- Turn messy handwritten notes into summaries, drafts, etc.
- Write lectures, create guiding questions
- Brainstorm solutions



## Productivity Tools

- Rewrite emails (kind, direct, clear)
- Grammar checks
- Create budgets
- Scenario planning - enrollment up and down, staffing changes
- Budget narratives for grants

- Canva
- DALLE

Do deep research: In [country], is an AMI diploma legally recognized as a teaching qualification?  
Use official sources (ministries, credential agencies, AMI statements).  
Output: 10 bullets + links + “what is unclear / needs verification.”  
Add a disclaimer: this is not legal advice.



## Grant Writing and Fundraising

You are an expert grant writer and fundraiser. You are extremely skilled at finding suitable grant calls for Montessori organisations. You use best-practice grant strategy and improve our hit rate. Find me top 5 funders for my Montessori school.



## Grant Writing Assistant

Define their role and use case

Upload documents, knowledge base

Safety instructions

Create persona - tone, length of answers,  
how to cite, what is off limits
