Requirements for Certification

(What you must do to receive the AMI 3-6 diploma):

- Minimum of 90% attendance at lectures and demonstrations of Montessori materials,
- Minimum of 90% attendance at all other components of the course (supervised practice, discussion, reading seminars, reviews and material making),
- Completion of 90 hours of observation and 90 hours of practice teaching in classrooms led by AMI 3-6 trained guides, and submission of observation and practical teaching reports,
- Submission of reference albums, assigned by the Trainer,
- Submission of required essays, student reflections and other written assignments,
- Successful completion of written and oral exams.

The Requirements for Certification Document is part of the legal documents which students sign once accepted to the course.

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Language of the Course:

The course will be given in English.

Interpretation into Czech can be considered if there is enough interest among the group. If you would benefit from Czech interpretation, please reach out to let us know.

Other Expenses:

Students need to budget for other expenses related to the course outside of the course fees, such as:

- Observation and practice teaching travel and accommodation expenses,
- Material making in the course, approximately €200,
- Printing of course compendiums for Reference Albums, if you decide to create your Albums in printed form,
- Obligatory reading books, which you need to purchase before the course starts,
- Annual Fee for AMI membership (obligatory for the time during which the course is given; it is purchased through the training center).

Application Process:

Applicants need to present satisfactory evidence of their ability to pursue academic work at a graduate level. Prior Montessori pedagogical education and experience is not required.
